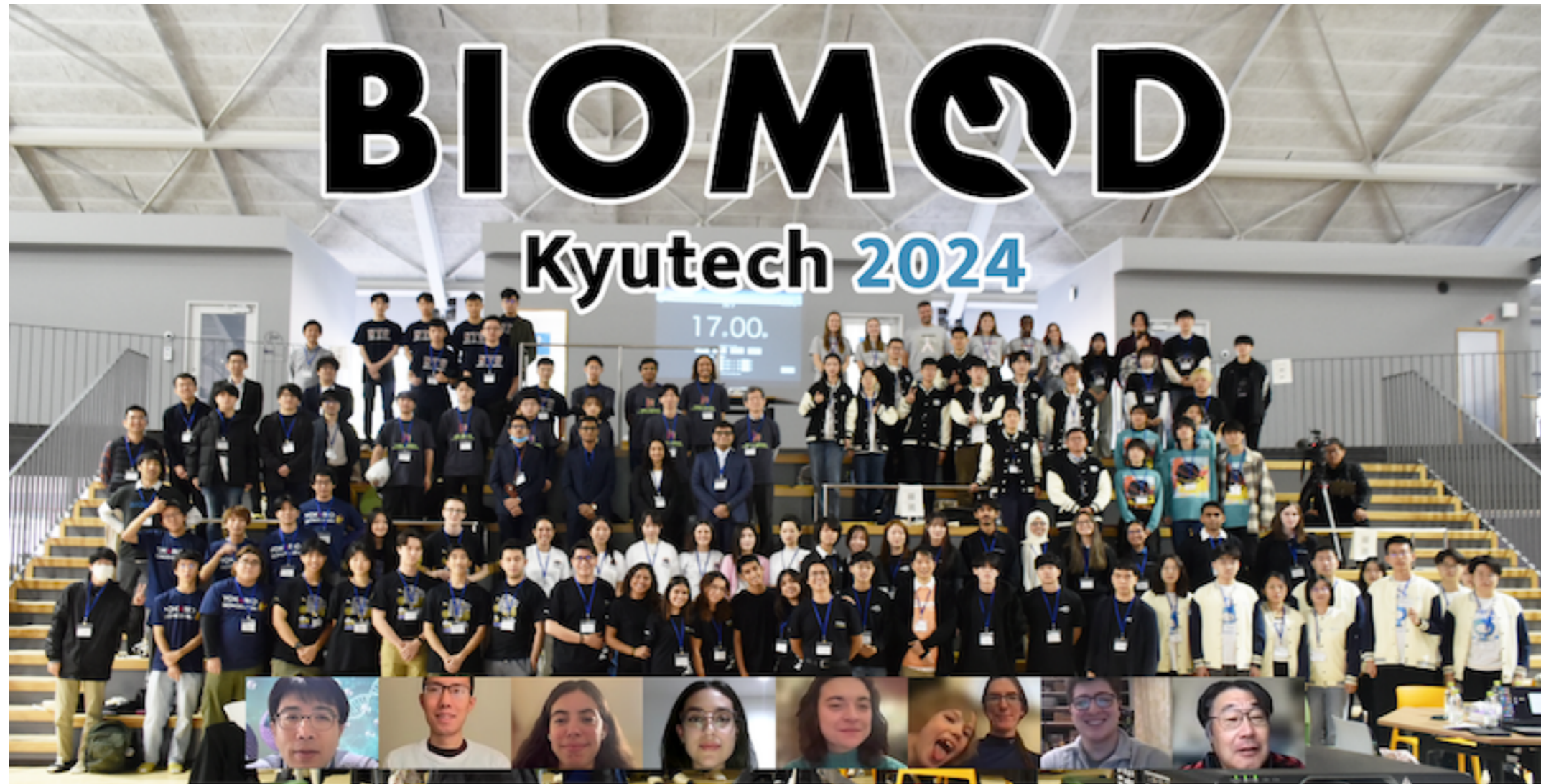

Overview (2)

- Started in 2011
- Intl. BIOMOD has been canceled since 2020 due to COVID-19
 - Japanese community continued as a domestic online competition (BIOMOD Japan Open, 2020-2022)
 - 2022: Expanded internationally by welcoming teams from overseas
- **Tokyo Tech 2023:** Relaunched International BIOMOD
- **Kyutech 2024:** Laying the foundation for future BIOMOD
 - Started Intl. Steering + Local Committee and the BIOMOD Institute
- Launched the Biomolecular Design Institute (Japan) (biomod.jp)
 - Started the BIOMOD Institute Slack Community (this month)
- **2025: Starting International Jamboree Venue Rotation**

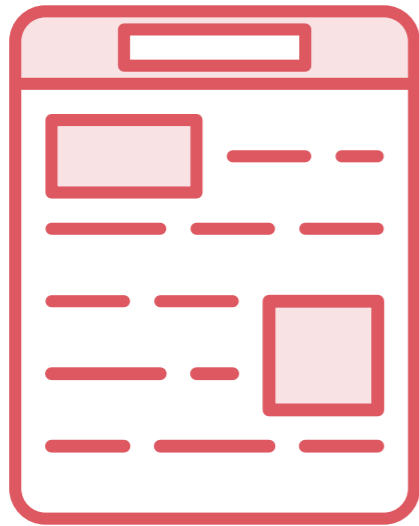
Eligibility

- Team: **1 team per institution**
 - Forming a joint team with multiple institutions is also allowed
- Member: **Max. 8 undergraduate students** per team
 - High-school students are also welcome to join a university-led team
 - Please decide on the primary contact person
 - Mentors are not included in the member headcount
- Mentor: Faculty advisors, Postdocs, Graduate students
 - At least **1 Faculty advisor** per team is required
 - No headcount limits for mentors
 - We kindly request mentors to participate as judges as well
 - **New: At least one mentor from faculty advisors or postdocs is required to join as a judge (either online or in-person at the jamboree)**

- Project theme and planning are entirely up to the team
- Deliverables and Scores (Total 100 pts.):

Awards

- **Top Prizes**

- Grand prize = 1st highest total combined points from wiki + video + presentation
- 1st runner up = 2nd highest total combined points from wiki + video + presentation
- 2nd runner up = 3rd highest total combined points from wiki + video + presentation

- **Category awards**

- Best Project Website = 1st place, 2nd place, 3rd place
- Best YouTube Video = 1st place, 2nd place, 3rd place
- Best Presentation = 1st place, 2nd place, 3rd place
- Audience favorite = 1st place, 2nd place, 3rd place

- **Project awards**

- Bronze: Team satisfied all minimum requirements for judging (Completed website, video, and presentation).
- Silver: Overall score is above 50% of all teams.
- Gold: Overall score is above 75% of all teams.

- **Special awards** (Decided based on voting at the jamboree)

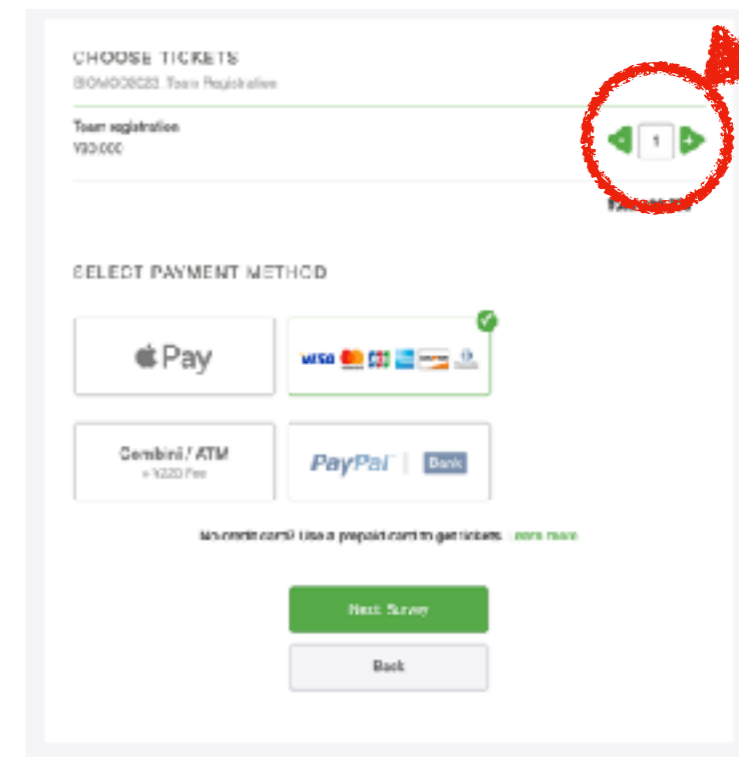
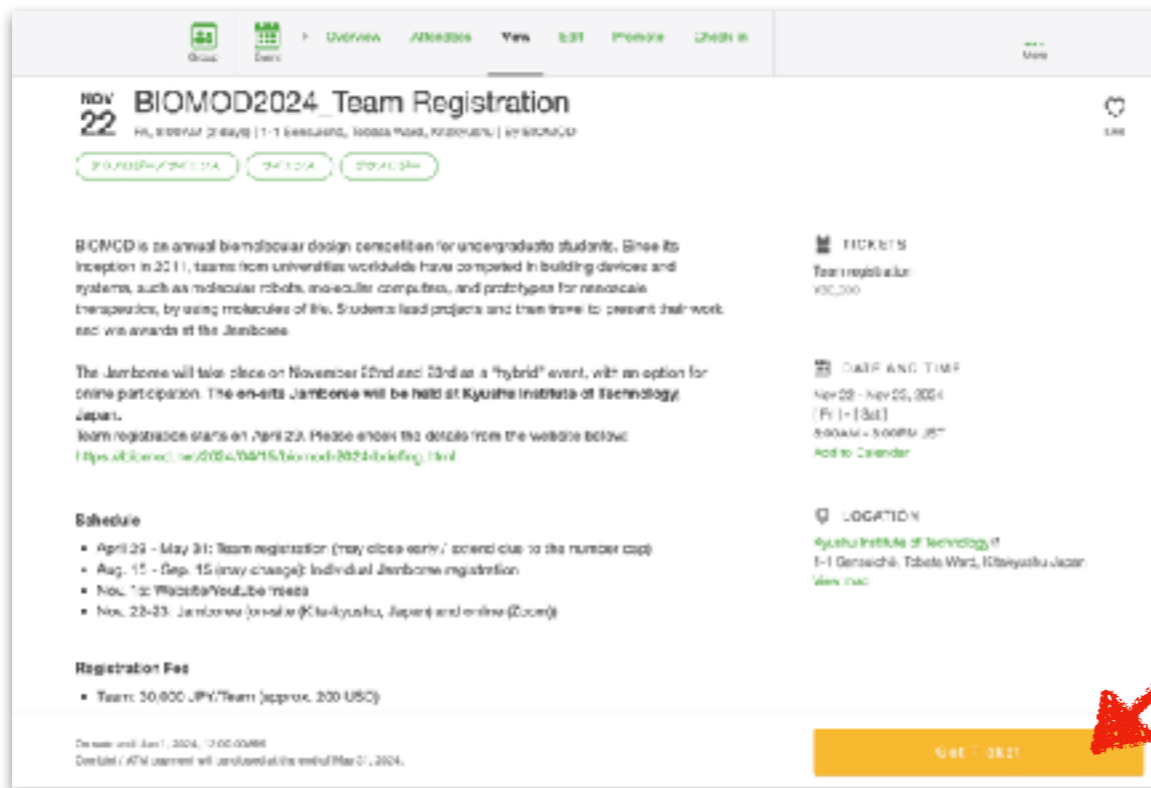

Timeline

- **April 18 - May 31:** Team registration (Peatix)
 - May close early / extend due to the number cap
- **Aug. 15 - Sep. 15:** Jamboree registration
 - incl. project title and abstract submission
(see <http://biomod.net/abstracts/> for previous examples)
- **Sep. 1:** Visa invitation letter requests due for international teams
- **Oct. 11:** Website/Video freeze
- **Oct. 17-19:** Jamboree (on-site (Changchun, China) and online (Zoom))
 - On-site practice slots will be available on October 17
 - **Day 1** (October 18): Presentation from each team, Social gathering (evening, after the presentation)
 - **Day 2** (October 19): Awards ceremony

Registration

- **Team registration** starts TODAY, now available via Peatix

 - Purchase a "ticket" (**one per team**)
 - Fee: 30,000 JPY (Credit Card, Apple Pay, PayPal)
 - Please answer the survey (contact info etc.)

 - <\$220 per person (on-site), TBD (online); will be decided based on the survey result
